11. Attach a budget for the project.

Required Supplementary Materials:

1. Documentation of current work and/or past presentations over last five years. The materials should include reviews, press articles, brochures, and/or programs.
2. A DVD or VHS work sample of a prior performance cued to a 7-minute section. This must be an unabridged representation of your work, NOT a montage of excerpts or "highlights" edited into a 7-minute section. Include a description of the work sample.
3. Attach a budget for the project.

4. If the project requires use of equipment from the BMCC Media Center, attach a statement outlining the technical support equipment needed for the project such as LCD projector, TVNCRIDVD monitor, laptop, and camera.

5. Include a headshot along with two (2) letters of recommendation or two (2) references with contact information.

6. Attach a listing of any upcoming performances you or your company may be involved in between the time of your application and June 1, 2008.
